Preparing Students for College and Careers

Introduction to Business

5 days/week

This exciting course is designed to give students insight into various aspects of everyday living in the business world. Various topics include management, leadership, consumer education, and business ethics. Students compete in the Stock Market Game simulation with classmates and other students in the region. Experience important tasks of personal and business finance and budgeting in the simulation "On Your Own."

Computer Business Applications (CBA)

3 or 5 days/week

This forward-thinking course is meant for both left-brained and right-brained students. You have the chance to be both analytical and creative as you explore various types of software and applications that are used in every day business and personal situations. Students will collaborate and communicate with the latest technology while creating projects in word processing, spreadsheets, databases, presentations, and desktop publishing. A focus will be also be on effective communication and the fundamentals of layout and design.

This fast-paced, fun course is sure to streamline your journey to the future- not just for business, but for any career you choose!

Principles of Computer Science Advanced Placement

5 days/week

The course is designed to build foundational knowledge and concepts of computer science. It is designed with a focus on multidisciplinary, creative problem solving and real-world applications as students are challenged to explore how computing and technology can impact the world.

This course meets the requirements for preparation for the AP Computer Science Principles exam. Part of the exam will be completed as in-class performance tasks for which students submit digital artifacts to demonstrate the skills they have developed. Topics include creativity in computing, abstraction, data and information, algorithms, programming, the Internet, and global impacts of computing and cybersecurity. Prior computer programming experience is not required; however, a grade of 83% or higher is required in Algebra I or Algebra I Accelerated.

FCAO Online Keyboarding

The objective for this course is to make you more efficient and accurate in typing longer documents and deliverables (without looking at your fingers). This is a skill that is tremendously valuable in the real working world and college/post-grad education, as the ability to keyboard proficiently and with minimal errors is required in creating any number of documents, presentations, and in submitting transactions.
