A Dorseyville Middle School student's interview with a World War II veteran is available to watch on YouTube.

Eloise Johnson, now a ninth-grader at Fox Chapel Area High School, spoke with Eugene Khorey about his experiences liberating a labor camp in Attendorn, Germany, in March 1945 as part of the Army's 86th Infantry Division. Mr. Khorey later received a Bronze Star.

Eloise asked him what he learned from his time there and called the interview a "powerful" experience - one that she will continue to carry with her.

"It gave me an appreciation for human beings," Mr. Khorey, of Munhall, told her. "It gave me a feeling that we can't survive unless we have better relationships with each other."
