ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION METHODS</p> <p>The Board may grant credit toward high school graduation for course work successfully completed through approved summer school, correspondence courses, distance learning, Internet, dual enrollment, Alternative Education and other forms of alternative course work in accordance with adopted policy.</p> <p>Students shall request in writing to the building principal approval of the proposed course and the number of credits sought.</p> <p>The course subject must be included in the high school’s planned instruction and relate to academic standards.</p> <p>The number of credits assigned to course work taken through an alternative delivery method shall be predetermined by the building principal and/or guidance counselor as part of the approval process before course work is begun.</p> <p>The student shall receive the same letter grade for high school credit that is assigned by the alternative education resource.</p> <p>The assigned student grade for successfully completed work shall not be weighted for purposes of computing the student’s grade point average, unless prior approval has been granted by the administrator and/or guidance counselor before the course work was begun.</p> <p><u>Summer School</u></p> <p>It is the policy of the Board that the district may conduct a summer program of remedial and/or enrichment instruction for resident students and other students the Board may admit.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
