	<b>713. PROTECTION OF PROPERTY</b>
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that school premises must be protected from vandalism, illegal entry and unauthorized use.
2. Authority 713-AR	The Board authorizes the Superintendent to establish regulations and procedures as necessary to carry out the intent of this policy.
3. Guidelines	<p><u>Trespassing</u></p> <p>Unauthorized presence shall be strictly forbidden on all school properties and within all school facilities. All facilities and properties will be conspicuously posted by all major entrances and such other places as necessary.</p> <p>The following guidelines shall apply:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. No trespassing shall be permitted on school property.</li><li>2. School personnel, enrolled students and visitors attending a function open to the general public, may enter at an appropriate time and place without specific consent.</li><li>3. All other visitors must obtain permission from the person in charge, normally the building principal.</li><li>4. Special recreation areas are open as posted.</li></ol> <p><u>Vandalism</u></p> <p>It shall be unlawful for any person to obscure, remove, deface, mark or destroy school facilities or equipment including any posted signs. Offenders will be prosecuted under provisions of the Pennsylvania School Code. Rewards may be offered for the apprehension and conviction of person(s) vandalizing school facilities.</p>
