718. SERVICE ANIMALS IN SCHOOLS	
1. Purpose	The Board adopts this policy to ensure that individuals with disabilities are permitted to participate in and benefit from district programs, activities and services, and to ensure that the district does not discriminate on the basis of disability.
2. Definition 28 CFR Sec. 36.104	Service animal means any guide dog, signal dog, or other animal individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability.
3. Authority 29 U.S.C. Sec. 794 42 U.S.C. Sec. 12101 et seq 43 P.S. Sec. 953	<p>The Board shall permit individuals with disabilities to use service animals in district buildings; on district property; and on vehicles that are owned, leased or controlled by the school district, upon request and submission of required documentation.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement Board policy and accommodate individuals with disabilities requesting use of a service animal in district buildings and on district property and vehicles.</p>
