208.1. WITHDRAWAL FROM A COURSE	
1. Purpose	This policy shall provide guidance to those students desiring to withdraw from a course.
2. Authority	The Board directs that students who carry only a minimal subject load may not withdraw from a course at any time.
3. Guidelines	<p>A student who is carrying more than the minimum course load may drop a course and not replace it with the following results:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A course dropped prior to the end of the first two (2) weeks of class will receive no notation on the high school transcript.2. If a student is achieving a passing grade in a course and the course is dropped after the first two (2) weeks but prior to the halfway point, WP (Withdrawal Passing) is recorded on the high school transcript and no credit shall be granted.3. Any course dropped after the halfway point or if the student is earning a failing grade at the time of withdrawal, WF (Withdrawal Failing) is recorded on the high school transcript and no credit shall be granted. <p>No course may be dropped after the tenth week of the semester.</p>
